CARPENTRY & SOLAR PANEL INSTALLATION (9-weeks)

This introductory program provides learners with the fundamental knowledge and practical skills needed to gain employment in the Solar Panel Industry and includes learning about:

- Hand & Power
- Document Use
- Sonotubes, Footings & Slabs
- Concrete Placement & Finishing
- Roofs
- Solar Panels theory, components, hardware, proper handling & installation

OPTION 2

Two Courses Back-to-Back

1. DRYWALL & PAINTING (3 weeks)

This introductory program provides learners with the fundamental knowledge and practical skills needed for drywall installation & painting, focusing on practical skills and includes learning about:

- Personal Protective Equipment; Site Hazards & Safety; Hand & Power Tools and Regulations; Industry Standards and Math for the Trades
- Drywall Applications and Finishing
- Surface prep techniques (cleaning, patching, sanding); Taping, Masking, and protecting nonpaint areas
- Using primers, interior/exterior paints, & finishes
- Brush, roller, and sprayer application methods
- Paint types (latex vs. oil, flat vs. gloss)
- Matching and mixing colors using virtual swatches
- Drying times, coats, and coverage rates

2. FLOORING: LAMINATE & TILE (6-weeks)

This introductory program provides learners with the fundamental knowledge and practical skills needed to gain employment in the construction industry and includes learning about:
